

### JUNE

Identification of G.D.A., or areas of special need. Council decides overall spending priorities for the city and debates district assessments.

## AUGUST TO DECEMBER

Programme Departments translate Priorities into 5 year plans . . . AND prepare guidelines for G.D.A., districts of special need in conjunction with public debate and with central government departments involved in the districts.

# NOVEMBER TO JANUARY

Committees review 5 year plans. Policy and Finance Committee review and approve 5 year plans for both the City and G.D.A.

### JANUARY TO FEBRUARY

Capital and manpower plans budgets established by Programme Departments for City and for G.D.A. for First year.

# **FEBRUARY TO MARCH**

Approval of budget, capital programme and manpower plan by personnel committee and City Council submission of supplementary expenditure for first year budget of G.D.A. submitted to Urban Policy Directorate [1]

#### MARCH TO JUNE


Effect of previous year's budget assessed for city and G.D.A. Approval of supplementary G.D.A. expenditure obtained from Urban Policy Directorate. Impact of previous year guides revision of priorities in G.D.A. and in the City, for the next years cycle to begin.
